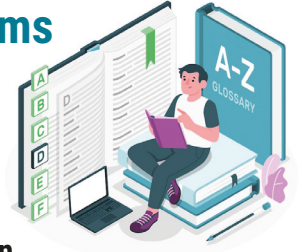


What your results mean

Your NGS test results show genetic changes (mutations) found in your cancer cells that can influence how your cancer grows and responds to treatment.

Types of Results You May Receive



Positive for Actionable Mutations

- ✓ Specific genetic changes found that can be targeted with treatments
- ✓ Your doctor can match these mutations with specific medicines

Example: "Your Cancer has a mutation called "BRAF V600E", which can be targeted"



Variants of Uncertain Significance

- ⚠ Genetic changes found, but their impact on treatment is not yet known
- ⚠ These findings may become important as research advances

Your doctor will focus on other factors for your current treatment plan



Negative for known actionable mutations

- ✗ No currently targeted mutations found
- ✗ Your doctor will recommend standard treatments for your cancer type
